

## Rules and Regulations

The following will be covered during the Burton 4-H Center orientation. Acquaint your students with these rules and regulations before your trip, and provide a copy to each chaperone.

**All visiting chaperones are expected to enforce these rules.**

- Listen to instructors and adults. A raised hand indicates that it is time to listen.
- Shoes, wet or dry, must be worn at **all times**.
- Absolutely **no swimming** allowed.
- Phones are not available to students.
- Do not leave money in the dorm.
- Only go in assigned dorm.
- Be punctual to classes, KP duty, and meals.
- Apply bug repellent outside.
- No running, climbing, or bouncing ball on the A-Frame roof.
- No students allowed on dock, trail, or marsh boardwalk without an adult.
- No food or drink in dormitories.
- Rinse off mud and sand **outside** at the hoses. Wet shoes can stay outside.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- Collect only empty shells. Shells are to be rinsed off outside, not in the sink.
- Students are responsible for cleaning their dormitories before departure. Cleanup is supervised by the adult chaperone(s) in that dorm.
- No one (under 18) is to leave the Burton 4-H Center without an adult.
- Put trash and recyclable goods in appropriate containers.
